## Police & Crime Commissioner for Derbyshire

Polling for this appointment takes place in the **Village Hall** on **Thursday, 15<sup>th</sup> November**.

### Bulk Skips

The Parish Council is positioning **Bulk Skips** on the **Village Hall Car Park** from **8.00 am to 12 noon** on **Saturday, 24<sup>th</sup> November**, for the disposal of household waste. NB: The following will not be accepted:

Commercial and green waste, hazardous/toxic/contaminated materials; refrigerators, freezers, TVs, VDUs, monitors, fluorescent light tubes, gas cylinders, fire extinguishers, batteries, oils, paints, liquids, asbestos, tyres, tarmac, plasterboard and food.

### Refuse collection

Amber Valley Borough Council has renegotiated its refuse collection. All recyclables (glass, tin, paper & cardboard) will be collected in one bin, with glass separated into an inner basket. Under the new system, plastic bottles will also be accepted. Household waste will continue to be collected in the existing bin. Collections will be on alternate weeks on the current days. The Borough aims to distribute the new bins by mid-November, to commence collections from the third week. A free green waste service will be introduced from Spring, 2013.

### Sir Henry Royce Commemorative Plaque

As mentioned in the *March Newsletter*, a **Plaque** is to be mounted on the gate-post of *Quarndon House*, 46 The Common, to commemorate **Sir Henry Royce**, co-founder of Rolls-Royce, who lived there from 1908-1911, during the setting up of the Company in Derby. It is to be **Unveiled** by Councillor Andrew Lewer, Leader of Derbyshire County Council, between **3 & 4 pm** on **Monday, 5<sup>th</sup> November**.

### Footpaths

A **permissive path** now gives access to **Allestree Park** from **Burley Lane**.

Following representations by the Parish Council, Kedleston Estate has promised to restore **Bridleway 13** (from Vine Cottages). It was made impassable by loose cattle.

## **Diamond Jubilee Seat**

The **Seat** in the **St Paul's Church Yard Extension**, commissioned by the Parish Council to commemorate the **Queen's Diamond Jubilee**, is now in place.



## **Telephone Box**

When BT withdrew its services to preserve what's been described as "this iconic item of street furniture for future generations", the Council – in common with many Parish Councils – bought the Village Telephone Box for £1. Several ideas for its future use have been considered – eg, a Book Exchange (as in Little Eaton); a Mini-Gallery to display Quarndon's art work; an Information Point. If you've any ideas, please submit them to a Parish Councillor for consideration at a future Meeting.

## **STOP PRESS**

The following notification from Derbyshire County Council has just been handed to the *Newsletter*.

### **Consultation for Derbyshire's Rights of Way Improvement Plan Draft Statement of Action, 2012 to 2017**

We are asking for people's views on our latest proposals for improving the network of paths and trails across Derbyshire over the next five years, including those in the Peak District National Park.

We produced our first Rights of Way Improvement Plan (ROWIP) in 2007, based on what people told us were the most important issues and what our priorities should be for meeting the needs of both local residents and visitors to the area. It included a statement of the action we proposed to take for the period from 2007 to 2012. We are now revising that statement of action to take us through the next five years to 2017.

We would like your views on what we are trying to achieve and whether you, or the organisation that you represent, agree with the way that we have prioritised the aims and identified the needs in the draft statement of action, or if there are any proposed actions that are missing.

We are producing this new document during a challenging time for local authorities in the face of continuing spending cuts. It is therefore even more important than ever to get your comments on how we can strike the right balance between being realistic about what can be achieved against the need to be aspirational.

The public consultation is open for a 12-week period, running from **6<sup>th</sup> August to 29<sup>th</sup> October, 2012**. The final document will then be published later this year. We want to encourage as many people as possible to view the draft statement of action on line and complete the questionnaire, which is available at:
