17/087 PUBLIC SPEAKING

A parishioner raised concerns about cars speeding along Memorial Road. It was agreed to raise the concerns to DCC and it was also suggested that parishioners raise the matter directly to DCC as well. It was agreed to invite the parishioner to the traffic sub group meeting.

A parishioner raised concerns that on the Poppyfields Meadow development there is no Secondary School catchment area allocated.

17/095 BARN CLOSE UPDATE

Councillor Hodson had drafted a response including opposition to the 400 houses Kedleston Road/600 Radbourne Lane, building on land liable to flooding and nomination as a key village. The meaning of 'key village' is not clear. It was agreed to send the response to AVBC.

17/101 NEW LITTERBIN

The proposed litter bin site had met with an objection. It was agreed to ask Amber valley DC to put the bin on the signpost at the corner of Montpelier and Burley Lane.
